Learning Objectives

KS1 I can name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans.

KS2 I can identify the position and significance of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere and time zones.

Geographical Skills

Use of globes/maps/atlas/digital mapping/technology to follow and plot a route.

Compass directions and grid references.

Activities

Ideal for whole school assemblies, but also in class or group work.

Using updates from James via video link or GIS tracker information track his position.

Discuss

- which oceans and seas has he crossed / which continents is he near?
- which hemisphere he is in in relation to the Equator?
- which lines of latitude has he crossed?
- which time zone is he in (what time is it where he is)?
- which country is he docking in / what is it like there / what will he see (possible independent research or homework task)?

Using a large world map involve the children in plotting the route so it is visible for all.
