Learning Objectives

Geographical Skills

Activities

Think of your own adventure. It could be in the local area to you or somewhere else in the world.

What is the purpose of the adventure? Why are you going to that place or complete that journey? What will you need? How will you prepare?

Persuasive writing - do you need help or funding? Adventures cost money so you might need to write to potential sponsors to ask for financial help.

History - look back and research famous adventurers from the past. How will your journey be similar or different to theirs?

Design a poster to publicise your adventure.

Research the place/places you will visit. What languages might you need, what foods might you taste? What are the main physical and human geography features you will encounter?

Write a story about an adventurer and their journey?
